



Dear Friends,

Thank you for volunteering to join in a trip to help the orphanage in Haiti. This will be a journey that will benefit many greatly for the efforts of just a few. Please read the details below and begin the necessary steps as soon as possible. The airline reservation and doctor's visit need to happen immediately to guarantee that you get a seat on the airplane and that you get the medical forms and inoculations done in a timely manner. So, here are the details....We look forward to joining forces to help the Renman Foundation and orphanage.

1. Book your round-trip airline reservation. Call or go online to American Airlines to book American Airlines Flight #2285 leaving Ft Lauderdale for Port Au Prince, Haiti, on Monday, June 7th at 2:15 in the afternoon. Everyone must be at the airport at least 2 hours before the flight (at 12:15) for the approximately 2 hour flight. The return portion of the flight needs to be American Airlines Flight #2288 on Sunday, June 13th leaving Port Au Prince, Haiti at 4:20 pm arriving in Ft Lauderdale at 7:20 pm. Please book today if you are able.
2. Consult your own doctor for physical and personal health needs for Haiti. There are several inoculations needed and individual medical precautions which your own doctor can review with you.
3. Get your passport to bring with you. Check it out to make sure that it is current and not expired.
4. Bring \$100 (more if you can) with you to the airport payable to Renman Foundation which will cover your food for the days you are there. (Approximately \$15 per day - not tax-deductible since it is food.) The menu will consist of items such as fish, vegetables, beans, rice, eggs and oatmeal. (Remember this is nourishment, not fine dining.)
5. Regarding clothes, please bring shorts, tee shirts and at least one pair of close-toed shoes and a hat to protect you from the sun.
6. Plan to bring the following items with you and plan to leave them in Haiti when you return:
 - a) A single inflatable mattress
 - b) A mosquito net - single with a circle on top
 - c) Lots of mosquito repellent
 - d) A flashlight and replacement batteries
 - e) A hand fan
7. Our contact person at the Renman Foundation is Florence Thybulle. Her phone number is 954-573-1154.

Renman foundation will supply towels and sheets for bedding. Be prepared for cold showers, very bumpy roads, very hot weather with no air conditioning. When in Haiti, expect to do the following and more: Help with cutting vegetables and cooking, help clear the brush from the new land, help with painting the buildings, and help build shelving... Bottom line - expect to help wherever
